Odors occur in all faucets.







Odors occur in some faucets.







Problem goes away after running the water for a few minutes. Problem does not go away after running the water for a few minutes.

Odor goes away after running the water for a few minutes.

Odor Cause: Is likely in your plumbing system, not your water source.



Only hot water smells.

Odor cause: is likely the magnesium rod in your hot water tank.



Both hot and cold water smell.

Odor Cause: Not easy to pin down. Either water source and/or your plumbing system.



Odor Cause: Is somewhere in the fixtures or pipes supplying those specific faucets.
